

Marine Is Fined

On Disorderly Count

Thomas Craig Whitney paid \$61 in fines and costs before District Magistrate Pat J. Maraglia Saturday on a charge of disorderly conduct.

Whitney had been arrested by Easton police early April 19. He apparently had strayed from a party being given by some friends, police said, and wandered into the house of Mrs. Clarine Boyer, 500 E. Charles St.

Whitney originally had been charged with prowling, loitering and unlawful entry. The charges were changed to disorderly conduct at the request of Mrs. Boyer.

Whitney is a marine stationed in North Carolina, police said.
